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What is a project?



- A project is a unique temporary activity that involves coordinated performance of interrelated operations to achieve certain goals in a time- and resource-constrained environment
- A project is a set of activities undertaken over the specified period of time with limited financial resources in order to achieve clearly defined goals
- A project is a set of activities developed and implemented by a Civil Society Institute that aim to achieve a specific goal over a specified period of time (usually no more than one year).

What is a project?

- A project is some kind of task with certain baseline data and expected outcomes (goals) determining the way it is addressed ("Code of Project Management", Project Management Institute, USA).
- A project is a series of activities aimed at meeting clearly defined goals within the stipulated time frame and within the existing budget (EuropeAID).
- A project is a temporary initiative with a clear indication of start and finish dates. It consists of one or more activities aiming at achieving certain outcomes and meeting a specific goal within the limited resources.





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Selection of a project idea

A PROJECT IDEA is the basic reason (basis) why we want to transmit a control action and whom / what we want to influence in order to achieve the desired changes in the public (community) life, in general or in a certain public sphere, in particular.

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Conceptual project application: the logic of its development

A project concept is a preliminary plan for the implementation of an idea (business idea) of a project, developed to assess the feasibility of this proposal (business proposal).

4. Project outputs

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PROJECT TITLE

It is formulated and finalized not at the beginning but rather gradually (iteratively) while writing the concept, at the end of its development.

The project title *coincides* nearly completely *(correlated) with the operational objective of the development strategy* for the community (city, region) which the project aims to implement.

The content of the project title is based on the overall objective of the project (which is determined by taking into account the project issue, stakeholders, product and project outputs, and reflects the limitations of the project).

The project aligns with the operational goals/ objectives of the following Development strategies:

- DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY FOR IVANO-FRANKIVSK OBLAST FOR THE PERIOD UP TO THE YEAR 2020
- DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY FOR IVANO-FRANKIVSK FOR THE PERIOD UP TO THE YEAR 2028
- COMMUNITY-BASED DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY

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PROBLEM

is defined as a negative phenomenon



A problem is an uncomfortable situation impairing functioning or development

A problem is a discrepancy between the existing and desired situations which requires intervention, and the course of action is characterized by considerable uncertainty.



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Causality

What caused the problem?

/problem symptoms (what's «wrong» and should be changed)

Are there several causes?

Are these causes interrelated?

EFFECTS

What are the effects of the problem?

How many people does it affect?

Are there any political, cultural or economic consequences?



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Logical framework of a project

FORMULATION OF THE OVERALL OBJECTIVE

Contains 1 or 2 sentences and consists of 2 parts

What is to be achieved

How it might be achieved

An example illustrating the project «THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN INNOVATION HUB in the city of N»

 Developing tourism, business and educational potential as well as the territory attractiveness by creating a modern innovative multifunctional community center in the city of N.



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The overall objective of a project is a model of a future product— the overall project outputs

Logical framework of the overall objective of a project

THE FIRST COMPONENT characterizes the global action which should be performed in the project in order to achieve tangible project outputs

- The availability of a tangible object can involve such actions as modernization, reconstruction, certification, implementation, liquidation, etc.
- If a tangible object is not available, it can be, depending on the level of the development of the project idea, *created*, *developed*, *built* etc.

THE SECOND COMPONENT is intended to provide a picture of the future project outputs, which corresponds with the name of the project outputs

THE THIRD COMPONENT contains *desirable project implementation indicators* such as timelines, cost, and, if possible, conditions for its implementation (local, environmental, etc.)








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Example illustrating the formulation of a problemoverall objective

- PROJECT TITLE: Establishment of incubators for youth-led startups in the town of Ivano-Frankivsk
- PROBLEM: The environment is too weak to support the growth of start-ups and young people are not sufficiently involved in it
- OVERALL OBJECTIVE: Developing the start-up environment and encouraging young people to develop creative thinking and to be more proactive









Preliminary analysis of project competition concept sustainability



- Applicants' admissibility criteria
- Students and post-graduates of the Precarpathian National University

Acceptance of targets

Correspondence between the project objectives and the overall objective of the competition

- Partners' acceptability criteria
- Students and post-graduates of the Precarpathian National University, members of regional communities, local authorities, stakeholders and orgnizations involved, etc.

Adequateness of activities

Activities which are not prohibited by the legislation of Ukraine



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PROJECT OBJECTVES no more than three

It is *a set (sequencing) of specific steps* which should be taken in order to improve the current situation.

A range of attained objectives refer to expected project outputs, i.e. show that the overall objective has been achieved.

An objective is usually expressed by means of the infinitive/gerund, which shows completeness: to increase/increasing, to accelerate/accelerating, to prepare/preparing, to develop/developing.

Examples of objectives:

Creating the environment favourable for the growth of start-ups: from developing a business-idea to running a successful business

Strengthening the involvement of young people in business by encouraging them to participate in start-up activities





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PROJECT ACTIVITIES

- ☐ Describe the activities, which aim at meeting each of the project objectives
- ☐ Each type of activity should be described separately
- ☐ *Information* on the ways, methods and process of the envisaged activities



Examples of project activities:

- Organizing 3 competitive start-up selection processes for an incubation program
- 2. Implementing 3 incubation programs
- 3. Organizing 3 launch events for "incubated" start-ups.



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PROJECT OUTCOMES



PROJECT OUTPUTS are the results of project activities obtained "at the output" after the project resources have been consumed: the construction of a tangible object, the development of a business process or a service, the implementation of an activity (A direct result)

Project outputs are a prerequisite for obtaining project outcomes **PROJECT OUTCOMES** are positive planned changes in the local external environment of the project (values) resulting from the fact that the stakeholders have used the project outputs **(A mid-**

PROJECT IMPACT refers to more global (remote) results, consequences which are viewed in the broader context (territotial, local, regional, society at large) (A long-term result)



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

Examples of project outputs and project outcomes

- Overall objective of the project: To develop and launch the batch production of 1200 units of vehicle exhaust fumes cleaners of new generation by December 15, 2018, within the project budget of 124.7 million UAH
- Project outputs: the batch of 1200 units of vehicle exhaust fumes cleaners has been produced in accordance with the customer's requirements and is stored in a warehouse
- Project outcomes: owing to the fact that vehicle exhaust fumes cleaners have been installed and used, the pollution of the air by gases decreased by 25 per cent in the central part of the city
- Impact the local environmental conditions have been improved







EXAMPLE

Expected outputs

QUANTITATIVE/QUALITATIVE

A co-working office for the projects going through the incubation period has been created/The startup environment has been developed

Three incubation programs have been implemented/The business skills of the incubation programs participants have been improved

20-25 start-up participants have been trained and consulted/The level of involvement of young people in business has increased by 10 per cent



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Innovation in local development

refers to any absolute or relative innovation in the form of a product (approach/ technology/ service) that leads to a qualitative change in the condition of the system and which, in accordance with the Law of Ukraine "On Innovative Activity", ensures the competitiveness of the created product and leads to a significant improvement in the standard and quality of life of the local community.

Innovations are newly created (applied) and (or) improved competitive technologies, products or services, as well as organizational and technical solutions of industrial, administrative, commercial or other nature, which significantly improve the structure and quality production and (or) social sphere






Project innovation criteria

- The "universal" notion of innovation which is traditionally applied is as follows: innovation is a product or service which is perceived as new in the market
- The innovativeness of local development projects can be represented in any form, including through technical, organizational, managerial, financial categories, and on the basis of distinguishing such concepts as "absolute" and "relative" «absolute» Ta «relative» innovation
- Project innovation is typically relative.

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Absolute and relative innovations in projects (examples)

If the result of a project implementation is a new product (product, technology, service, etc.) which is the first of its kind in the world (know-how), and which can be patented, such a product is an absolute innovation

If a project envisages, for example, the introduction or improvement of an energy-saving system in a particular locality, the installation of energy-saving light bulbs in combination with other measures and the parallel installation of solar panels and external insulation of houses, such an integrated approach is a relative innovation

Local and regional development projects are typically based on relative innovation

The product created as a result of such projects may have analogues in the world. But ... If you consider the local conditions and realities, you'll see that the created product IS new for this very village, for this very territory, which will make **your project unique and innovative.**
